

Wittenberg Symposium on “Schleiermacher’s Educational Theory” (November 1-3, 2018): **Travel Stipends**

The International Schleiermacher Society is once again offering two travel stipends for international participants in its autumn symposium:

- 400 Euro for a European participant from outside of Germany
- 700 Euro for a participant from outside of Europe

The stipends are awarded with the expectation that the recipients will give a presentation of their project at the symposium and take part in all of its proceedings. Applications should contain a brief (one-page, double-spaced) explanation of the applicant’s motivation for wishing to attend the symposium, a brief description of your project (also one-page), and a C.V. Basic facility with spoken German is presupposed and should be addressed somewhere in the application.
